

An Indian Adventure



Come; visit the Kanha National Park-home to the Royal Bengal tiger; see the magnificent 'Taj Mahal' and the multi- cultural capital city of the country- New Delhi.

Day 1, Welcome to India



You'll arrive in Mumbai, the commercial capital of India. Your flight will arrive around midnight and you will be transferred to your hotel. Spend the night here, and continue on your trip to Kanha National Park tomorrow morning.

OVERNIGHT - MARATHA SHERATON

Day 2, Mumbai / Nagpur / Kanha

Take the morning flight to Nagpur; and drive to the Kanha National Park from there.

Kanha is one of India's largest national parks, covering 1945 km² and was one of the first nine reserves selected for the Project Tiger in 1973. Around 25 species of animals are regularly spotted in the central parklands, and the highly endangered barasingha is found in many parts of the jungle, as are over 200 species of birds.





'The Jungle Book' author Rudyard Kipling found inspiration here and when you need a tiger fix, this park offers as close to a guarantee as you'll get. Approximately 125 tigers reside in the park, and guides spend considerable amounts of time scouting their locations. Good viewing months are from March to June; the park closes from June to mid October.

Arrive at Kanha in the evening and check in to your tented suite at the 'Banjaar Tola' lodge. Meet your expert naturalist, who will give you a full orientation of what to expect on your safari drives into the jungle. Take



time off to unwind before you get ready for cocktails and dinner around the bonfire.

OVERNIGHT - BANJAAR TOLA

Day 3, Kanha




Go for an early morning game drive through the jungle, in modified safari vehicles. Return to the lodge for a quiet breakfast beside the river.

Spend the rest of morning at the lodge. The


tented suites are set along the banks of the Banjaar River, overlooking the core area of the Kanha National Park. Wide glass doors open onto private decks overlooking the river, offering panoramic views of the wilderness beyond.

Day4, Kanha

Go for an early morning bird watching tour in the company of a resident naturalist. Try your luck at spotting Kanha's ten Star Birds among the more than 200 bird species in the Park.

Have breakfast in the woods, and return to the

Go on a game safari in the evening. Pause at sunset point to watch the sun sinking down over the jungle and enjoy a thirst-quenching cocktail.

Day 5, Kanha / Raipur / Delhi

Have an early breakfast and drive to Raipur to board the flight to Delhi.

You will arrive in Delhi in the evening, and will be transferred to 'The Imperial' hotel. Have dinner at the hotel.

OVERNIGHT - THE IMPERIAL

Day 6, DELHI



In 'New Delhi', drive past the Parliament House, the Presidential Palace - Rashtrapati Bhawan and 'India Gate' - all built during British rule. India Gate is the famous war memorial dedicated to martyrs of World War I.

Visit one of the country's most striking monuments


Go for a sightseeing tour of the city today.

Visit Old Delhi in the morning and New Delhi later in the afternoon.

In 'Old Delhi', see the majestic 'Jama Masjid' - India's largest mosque; and take a rickshaw ride through the narrow, bustling streets of 'Chandni Chowk'.




- the 70-meter high Qutab Minar - that marked the site of the first



Muslim kingdom in Northern India, in the 12th century. It is, at present, the tallest brick minaret in the world.

Also see Humayun's Tomb, the first ever

Mughal garden tomb to be constructed in the subcontinent. Visitors are immediately struck by the tomb's resemblance to its more famous cousin - the Taj Mahal.



Day 7, Delhi / Agra / Delhi/Home

Fake the early morning train to Agra. (Shatabdi express).



Visit the Taj Mahal and the Red fort.

Taj Mahal: One of the Seven Wonders of the World, built by Emperor Shah Jehan in memory of his beloved consort Mumtaz Mahal, this beautiful mausoleum is made of white marble and is an architectural masterpiece.


Agra Fort: Built by
