DAY ONE

On arrival in Cape Town guests will be given a traditional African Welcome. African Maidens will greet the group with a string of friendship beads and they will be escorted to the luxury coach.

Welcome drinks on arrival at their 5 star hotel followed by an opportunity to freshen up.

Welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Overnight: Cape Town

DAY TWO

Full day in the Cape Winelands. An opportunity to visit the Capes wine estates with their historical Cape Dutch homesteads and award winning wines. In addition to estate and cellar tours, the group will sample a selection of the estate wines at a private tasting. The group will also have the option for a cheese tasting, chocolate tasting and olive oil tasting.

A visit to the Spier estate will allow the group an up close and personal experience with a Cheetah – brilliant photo opportunity and once in a lifetime experience.

Lunch at one of the Estates, an opportunity to enjoy magnificent views complimented by exquisite cuisine paired with appropriate wines.

A stop at the town of Stellenbosch to visit the quaint shops, museums and coffee shops before returning to the hotel in the late afternoon.



Dinner transfer to Blouberg for an African themed dinner at Moyo. Traditional African traditions including handwashing ceremonies, African face painting, traditional African music and dance and delicious food from around the African Continent.

Overnight: Cape Town

DAY THREE

The drive to Cape Point takes the group along Chapmans Peak – regarded as one of the world’s most scenic coastlines.

Today the group will visit Cape Point (rumoured to be the meeting point of the Indian and Atlantic Ocean), Boulders Penguin Colony and enjoy a seafood banquet.

Other highlights include an optional canoe paddle with the penguins, helicopter flights and a trip on the back of a Harley Davidson along the coast (all these are available at a supplementary charge).

This evening dinner will be at the Grand Beach restaurant. At this trendy upmarket venue the group will dine with the sand between their toes and the waters edge only metres away. Situated adjacent to the V&A Waterfront, this restaurant is the only restaurant in Cape Town situated on the beach.

Overnight: Cape Town

DAY FOUR

Before travelling to the airport for the onward flight an opportunity to bid farewell to Cape Town from Table Mountain.

Ascend the mountain by cableway where the group will be able to explore the mountain whilst still enjoying the luxury of a private viewing area reserved exclusively for them. A sparkling wine toast before descending the mountain and continuing to the airport for the onwards flight to the bush. Lunch on board the flight.

On arrival in Johannesburg travel by luxury coach to the vast entertainment complex of Sun City.

Afternoon at leisure to enjoy the myriad of options available. Including golf, spa facilities, crocodile farm, game drives, walks, cultural village, waterworld, adventure centre, zip lining, several swimming pools, slot machines, casinos and so much more.



Dinner at The Shebeen. Shebeens were illegal drinking taverns in the Apartheid era. A place for the locals to meet, listen to music, dance, enjoy good food and hang out. A perfect replica is situated on the Sun City property, and a short shuttle trip from the hotel.

Overnight: Sun City

DAY FIVE

Breakfast at leisure.

Transfer to the Elephant enclosure for an up close interaction with these majestic creatures. The experience will include an opportunity to feed the animals, touch them, and for a lucky few there is even the option to continue on an Elephant Back safari through the game reserve.

Lunch in the boma over looking the waterhole where the antics of the elephants can be enjoyed.

Afternoon game drive in search of the Big 5, prolific insects and birds as well as a myriad of other animals. A game drive in Africa is wonderful and mysterious, with no two drives ever being the same. These experiences will forever leave an imprint in each guests mind.

As the dusk turns into evening, the night safari begins. This is the time for viewing the nocturnal creatures of the bush. The drive concludes at a clearing in the bush where a Boma Dinner under the canopy of the African Stars will be awaiting. During dinner guests will be entertained by traditional African dance and music.
