



BUSH AND CAPE TOWN

5 NIGHTS

DAY ONE

On arrival in Cape Town guests will be given a traditional African Welcome. African Maidens will greet the group with a string of friendship beads and they will be escorted to the luxury coach.

Welcome drinks on arrival at their 5 star hotel followed by an opportunity to freshen up.

Welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant.

DAY TWO

Full day in the Cape Winelands. An opportunity to visit the Capes wine estates with their historical Cape Dutch homesteads and award winning wines. In addition to estate and cellar tours, the group will sample a selection of the estate wines at a private tasting. The group will also have the option for a cheese tasting, chocolate tasting and olive oil tasting.

A visit to the Spier estate will allow the group an up close and personal experience with a Cheetah – brilliant photo opportunity and once in a lifetime experience.

Lunch at one of the Estates, an opportunity to enjoy magnificent views complimented by exquisite cuisine paired with appropriate wines.

A stop at the town of Stellenbosch to visit the quaint shops, museums and coffee shops before returning to the hotel in the late afternoon.



Dinner transfer to Blouberg for an African themed dinner at Moyo. Typical African traditions including handwashing ceremonies, African face painting, African music and dance and delicious food from around the African Continent.

DAY THREE

The drive to Cape Point takes the group along Chapman's Peak – regarded as one of the world's most scenic coastlines.

Today the group will visit Cape Point (rumoured to be the meeting point of the Indian and Atlantic Ocean), Boulders Penguin Colony and enjoy a seafood banquet.

Other highlights include an optional canoe paddle with the penguins, helicopter flights and a trip on the back of a Harley Davidson along the coast (all these are available at a supplementary charge).

This evening dinner will be at the Grand Beach restaurant. At this trendy upmarket venue the group will dine with the sand between their toes and the water's edge only metres away. Situated adjacent to the V&A Waterfront, this restaurant is the only one in Cape Town situated on the beach.

DAY FOUR

Before travelling to the airport for the onward flight an opportunity to bid farewell to Cape Town from Table Mountain.

Ascend the mountain by cableway where the group will be able to explore the mountain whilst still enjoying the luxury of a private viewing area reserved exclusively for them. A sparkling wine toast before descending the mountain and continuing to the airport for the onwards flight to the bush. Lunch on board the flight.

On arrival in the bush, the group will be welcomed by their ranger and tracker and transferred to their private lodge. After a short welcome and briefing, off on your first African safari. An opportunity to view the prolific wild life, birds and flora in the region.

Dinner in the boma, an open air enclosure. Dine under the African skies whilst being entertained by traditional song and dance.

DAY FIVE

Another perfect day in Africa. An early morning wake up followed by refreshments on the deck before the morning safari. Spend the remainder of the day enjoying a game walk, relaxing at the pool or being pampered in the lodge spa. The evening safari departs in the late afternoon and continues to dinner in the bush. A unique experience, dinner surrounded by the sights, sounds and smells of the bush. A large fire will burn to keep the wild animals away. A drumming circle around the fire makes the perfect ending to the groups African experience.
